Petitioner seeks regular bail in FIR No.156 dated 09.02.2016, under Sections 302, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sadar Gurgaon, District Gurgaon. The petitioner was arrested on 14.03.2016 and is in jail since then.

I have seen the evidence of witnesses recorded before the trial Court. Prima-facie, there is no evidence against the present petitioner.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned. Petitioner shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence, threaten or exercise any influence on the prosecution witnesses.
