This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for setting aside the order dated 23.12.2010 whereby the petitioner was declared a proclaimed offender in FIR No.238 dated 10.12.2007 registered under Section 324, 323, 34 of the IPC (charges framed under Sections 325, 232, 34 of the IPC) registered at Police Station Dharmkot District Moga. Learned counsel submits that the trial of co-accused has concluded and they have been acquitted since the complainant did not support the version of the prosecution. The petitioner has been residing abroad since 2008.

In the facts and circumstances of this case, it is directed that the petitioner will surrender before the trial court at Moga within 15 days from today. Upon which the trial court would release the petitioner on interim bail, subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to its satisfaction.

Disposed of accordingly.
