Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.51 dated 27.05.2017, under Sections 341, 324, 326, 323, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC'), registered at Police Station Sadar Gurdaspur, on the basis of compromise.

Learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned counsel for respondent No.2 submit that the compromise has been arrived at between the parties. Petitioners No.1 and 2 and respondent No.2 are real brothers.

This Court had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court for recording of statements. Pursuant thereto, now, there is a report from learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gurdapur stating that the statements have been recorded and the compromise is

voluntarily without any pressure.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed. FIR No.51 dated 27.05.2017, under Sections 341, 324, 326, 323, 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Gurdaspur alongwith all consequential proceedings, is quashed by way of compounding/compromise.
