The FIR was lodged by the brother of deceased on 14.02.2016 in which he mentioned the name of one Om Parkash as being involved in his brother's murder along with certain unidentified persons. Admittedly, the present petitioner was not named in the FIR. He was, nevertheless, challaned along with three others, namely, Dharambir, Sheela and Kamlesh.

Subsequently, after examination of the complainant in the trial Court, where he allegedly turned hostile, co-accused Dharambir was granted bail by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court on 26.04.2017 in CRM-M-13294-2017, giving detailed reasons.

The present petitioner stands on identical footing with the said co-accused. As such considering the long detention undergone by him, the petitioner may be similarly released on regular bail to the satisfaction of Ld. trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Sonapat.
