Petitioners-Dalbir Singh, Kuldeep Kaur and Kulwant Kaur have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.32 dated 29.03.2017, registered at Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran, under Sections 323, 324, 452, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

Learned counsel for the petitioners wants to withdraw this petition qua petitioner No.1-Dalbir Singh with liberty to file afresh one with better particulars.

Dismissed as withdrawn qua petitioner No.1-Dalbir Singh.

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So far as petitioner Nos.2 and 3 are concerned, no injury is attributed to them.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 07.07.2017 passed by this Court, petitioner Nos.2 and 3 have already joined the investigation. They are not required for custodial interrogation. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending petitioner Nos.2 and 3 to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition qua petitioner Nos.2 and 3 and the same is allowed accordingly. The order dated 07.07.2017, granting interim bail to petitioner Nos.2 and 3, is made absolute. However, petitioner Nos.2 and 3 shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
