The involvement of the petitioner transpired in FIR No.190 dated 17.09.2012 under Sections 379, 411, 471 & 472 of the Indian Penal Code (in short 'IPC') registered at Police Station Sadar Amritsar, District Amritsar. He was granted bail during the investigation. Subsequently, challan was submitted against him. He claims not to have received any notice for appearance in Court after completion of investigation. He was, therefore, declared a Proclaimed Offender. After knowing about the proceedings, he voluntarily surrendered in the Ld. trial Court on 01.05.2017, but bail was denied to him in view of his 'conduct'.

In the opinion of this Court, further detention of the petitioner, after having remained incarcerated for over two and a half months now pursuant to his surrender in the Ld. trial Court, is not called for at this stage.

The petitioner is, therefore, ordered to be released on regular

bail subject to imposition of appropriate terms and conditions as deemed fit
by the Ld. trial Court/Area Magistrate concerned.
