ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.182 dated 26.10.2014 under Sections 323/324/506/148/149 IPC (Sections 452/307/427 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Laddowal, District Ludhiana City.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR are that the petitioner had given *danda* blows on the stomach and back of injured Saurav, which were found to be simple injuries. Learned counsel further contends that the main accused Pindi, who had given *datar* blow on the head of complainant, has already been released on regular bail.

This Court by the order dated 10.07.2017, had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the

satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from HC Kamaljit Singh, states that in pursuance to the order dated 10.07.2017, the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 10.07.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
