After having been granted concession of regular bail by this Court, the petitioner, during course of trial, absented on 20.12.2016 as such non-bailable warrants were issued against him.

While notice under Section 82 Cr.P.C had been issued to declare him P.O, the petitioner during pendency of the proceedings, surrendered in the Court on 23.05.2017 and applied for bail. His application for bail was declined not accepting the medical grounds put forth by the petitioner for his absence on 20.12.2016.

The petitioner has been in custody since 23.05.2017. The period of detention suffered by the petitioner appears to be sufficient enough to have a deterrent effect upon the petitioner not to absent himself again.

The petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bonds with two surities to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the conditions that the petitioner will not absent himself without any sufficient cause/prior intimation to the Court; he will not tamper with the evidence and will not in any manner hamper the investigation.
