The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.50 dated 17.04.2017 registered for offences punishable under Sections 482, 411 and 379-B of Indian Penal Code (for short, "IPC") at Police Station Model Town, District Hoshiarpur.

Heard.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the court, Mr. Ajay Pal Singh Gill, DAG, Punjab, DAG, Punjab, who is present in the Court accepts notice and submits that intimation by Registry informing of fixation of the petition has already been received and record of the case is available with him.

The petitioner was arrested in this case and from his possession Activa scooter having forged number-plate, which was stolen property, was recovered alongwith five mobile phones and two bank passbooks.

Learned State counsel submits that there were snatching in the area and petitioner in his disclosure statement has admitted those snatching.

However, no recovery relating to those snatching has been effected from the petitioner.

The petitioner was arrested on 17.04.2017 and the matter is still under investigation.

In view of above but without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of investigation and trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Inderjit Singh @ Inder is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
