Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Balwinder Pal who is present in Court to assist him, submits that upon police officials from Police Station Sarhali, District Tarn Taran, having contacted the petitioners, the statements of the petitioners, the mother of the petitioners, a maternal uncle and some other persons have been recorded, to the effect that the said respondents have accepted the marriage of the petitioners to each other and as such there is no longer any threat to their life and liberty.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous but with a direction to respondents no. 2 and 3 to ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioners remains continued to be protected, as per law.
