ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.48 dated 18.03.2017 under Sections 21 and 22 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Maloya, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that allegations against the petitioner are that he was found in possession of 15 grams heroine and 10 injections of Buprenorphine of 2 ML each which is far less than the commercial quantity. The commercial quantity of heroine is 250 grams while that of Buprenorphine is 20 grams. He also contends that petitioner has been in custody for over four months ever since his arrest on 18.03.2017.

Learned Public Prosecutor states that challan has been filed but the CFSL report is still awaited.

In view of the fact that the recovery is below the commercial

quantity and the petitioner has been in custody for over four months, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner-Amandeep Garg is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Chandigarh.
