The present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for grant of bail to the petitioner in case First Information Report No.50 dated 25.6.2014 registered under Sections 363, 366-A, 376, 341, 323, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Section 4 and 8 The Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 (for short 'Act 2012') at Police Station Begowal, District Kapurthala.

On 7.7.2017, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel submits that the petitioner was earlier summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. She was allowed anticipatory bail. The summoning order was set aside by this Court and matter was remanded to the trial Court for decision afresh. He further submits that the trial Court has again summoned the

petitioner under Section 319 Cr.P.C. and she is ready to appear before the trial Court on the date fixed i.e. 10.07.2017.

Notice of motion, returnable by 15.09.2017.

The petitioner shall appear before the trial Court on 10.07.2017. On appearance, she shall be admitted to interim bail subject to her furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.

A copy of the order be produced on the next date of hearing.

In pursuance of the said order, the petitioner has produced the copy of the order dated 10.7.2017 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Kapurthala, vide is taken on record as Mark 'A'. As per the same, the petitioner has furnished bail bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 7.7.2017 is made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall abide by the condition as enshrined under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
