Petitioner Sanjeev Sharma has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for setting aside the order dated 21.09.2015 passed by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Kurukshetra in a petition under Section 125(3) Cr.P.C. and to set aside the order dated 07.06.2016 passed in CRR No.239 of 2015 passed by the learned Sessions Judge, Kurukshetra under Section 397 CR.P.C. and all the consequent proceedings arisen therefrom.

Both the parties have amicably compromised their matrimonial dispute. They filed a joint petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act. Their statements in first motion and second motion had been recorded in terms of the compromise entered into between them. A decree of divorce by mutual consent was passed by us today.
