The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.106 dated 13.06.2017, under Sections 21/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, registered at Police Station Jakhal, District Fatehabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been arraigned as an accused on the statement of Rakesh Kumar from whom 7 grams of smack was recovered.

This Court, by the order dated 10.07.2017, had directed the petitioner to join the investigation and he was to be released on anticipatory bail subject to his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Dharam Pal, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

The petitioner has been arraigned as an accused on the statement of Rakesh Kumar from whom 7 grams of smack was recovered, which is far below the threshold of 250 grams of commercial quantity. The petitioner has joined the investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 10.07.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
