When this case came up for hearing on 12.12.2016, following
order was passed by this Court:-

*“As per the report of the office, respondents No.2
to 6 have already died, but their legal representatives have not
been impleaded so far. Respondents No. 7 to 9 are not residing
at the given address. The service of respondents No.11 and 12
has already been dispensed with.*

*The appellant is directed to take steps to implead
the legal representatives of respondents No.2 to 6 and to file the
correct/present address of respondents No.7 to 9 within one
month and then notice to respondents No.7 to 9 be issued for
03.07.2017.”*

Thereafter, on 3.7.2017, following order was passed by this
Court:-

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“Mr. Amardeep Singh Walia, Advocate who has filed his Memo of appearance on behalf of Piara Singh son of appellant Lekh Singh informed that appellant Lekh Singh has died. He seeks time to move the application for bringing on record the legal representatives of appellant as well as respondents No.2 to 6.

Needful be done within one month.

List the case for 22.08.2017.”

As per office report dated 19.8.2017, neither learned counsel for the appellant filed correct addresses of respondents No. 7 to 9, nor any application for bringing on record legal representatives of respondent Nos.2 to 6 has been moved.

It seems that neither appellant nor his counsel is interested in pursuing this appeal.

In view of the above, present appeal is dismissed for non-prosecution.
