The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.107 dated 06.10.2016, under Sections 498-A of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Bullowal, District Hoshiarpur.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners contends that the allegations made in the FIR are general in nature and only to harass the petitioners.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and find that no ground is made out to interfere at this stage. All pleas that are available to the petitioners, to be taken up in the proceedings pending before the trial court at Hoshiarpur.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioners contends that on

account of being senior citizens, the petitioners may be permitted to appear through their counsel, while giving the undertaking that they will appear in the court, as and when required.

The prayer of the counsel for the petitioners is allowed.

The petitioners are permitted to appear through their counsel before the trial court, on furnishing the undertaking that they will be present in the court as and when required.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
