Perused the FIR, which clearly shoes that 6500 tablets of Clovedol and 1000 tablets of Alprax were seized from the possession of the petitioner.

In that view of the matter, the petitioner was founding possession of total 7500 tablets.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that nothing was seized from him. That is neither here nor there. Since he ran away from the spot, the grant of anticipatory bail cannot be ruled out in such cases.
