Heard learned Counsel for the rival parties. The petitioner seeks regular bail in FIR No.275 dated 28.9.2015, under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur. Learned Counsel for the State was directed to find out any other case registered or pending against the petitioner. Now there is a report by Learned Counsel for the State that the petitioner was acquitted in the other case. Petitioner was arrested on 28.9.2015 and is in jail since then for having been found in possession of intoxicating medicines. The petitioner would furnish an undertaking not to commit any offence. The trial will take its own time. In view of the undertaking, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial court/CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.
