CRM-M-24828-2016

Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C has been made for quashing FIR No.27 dated 04.02.2012 for offence punishable under Sections 324, 326, 341, 506 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar, as also all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 15.07.2016 (Annexure P-2).

Pursuant to the order dated 23.07.2016 of this Court, the parties appeared before the learned Illaqa Magistrate to get recorded their statements. Learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Phillaur has sent its report vide covering letter having Endorsement No.6233 dated 09.08.2016, which has been

duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Jalandhar, vide Endorsement No.2105(GJRK) dated 10.08.2016.

According to the report, the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Phillaur is satisfied that the parties have made an amicable settlement and have got recorded their statements voluntarily in the Court. Considering the report of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Phillaur dated 09.08.2016 and the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, FIR No.27 dated 04.02.2012 for offence punishable under Sections 324, 326, 341, 506 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar, as also all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua petitioners only namely, Kamaljit Singh, Mukhtiar Singh and Manjinder Singh @ Mani.

However, it is made clear that the FIR against Tirath Singh-shall remain in force.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
