Pursuant to the order dated 19.07.2017, report dated 02.08.2017 has been received from Sh. R.K. Mehta, Additional District & Sessions Judge, Gurugram.

According to the said report, there are 34 prosecution witnesses, out of whom, one PW-Jaiveer has been examined. It is further stated that trial is likely to be concluded within six months.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after six months (February-2018) in case the trial is not concluded by them.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.

However, it is made clear that the benefit of this order will not be granted to the petitioner in case the trial is not concluded within six months on account of delay tactics adopted by the petitioner or his counsel.
