This petition has been filed by the petitioner for issuance of direction to respondents no.1 to 3 to initiate proceedings against respondents no.5 to 8.

A DD report was entered wherein no allegations were levelled upon anyone. A week later a complaint had been given by the complainant.

The petitioner is seeking directions to the police. Postmortem report has been seen. There is no injury. The petitioner had also approached the Human Right Commission and the concerned SSP had been directed to look into the matter and dispose off the same at their own level. The order was passed on 01.06.2017.

In the above circumstances, no directions are required to be passed. Even otherwise the complainant has a remedy and can avail of it.

The petition is disposed off.
