The petitioners are seeking a direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty as they apprehend danger from respondents No. 4 to 6.

It is stated in the petition that the date of birth of petitioner No. 1 is 20.09.1997 and petitioner No. 2 is 21.07.1993. Copies of their Adhaar cards are annexed with the petition as Annexures P-1 and P-2, respectively. They are stated to have solemnized their marriage on 02.01.2017. Copies of the marriage photographs are annexed as Annexure P-4.

Issue notice to respondents No. 2 and 3 only.

At the asking of the Court Mr. C.S. Brar, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 2 and 3.

Without expressing any opinion on the validity of the marriage

and keeping in view the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of *Lata Singh Vs. State of U.P. and another*, JT 2006(6) SC 173, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2- Commissioner of Police, District Amritsar to look into the matter and take appropriate action in accordance with law to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of the private respondents.
