Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing DDR No.33 dated 03.09.2010 under Sections 452, 506, 323, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code arising out of F.I.R. No.73 dated 03.09.2010 registered under Sections 452, 506, 323, 325, 148 and 149 IPC, at Police Station Nangal, District Rupnagar, on the basis of compromise dated 16.03.2017 (Annexure-P2).

Vide order dated 12.07.2017 passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/ Illaqa Magistrate on 08.08.2017 for recording of their statements for compromise with a direction to the trial Court/ Illaqa Magistrate to furnish a report alongwith the recorded statements qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties had appeared before the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sri Anandpur Sahib on 08.08.2017 and got recorded their statements for compromise and report from the concerned Magistrate has also been received vide covering letter bearing No.298 dated 31.08.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Rupnagar vide Endst. No.9742 dated 20.09.2017 in the connected case bearing CRM-M-23316-2017.

According to the report of Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sri Anandpur Sahib, the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily, without any undue influence, pressure and coercion from any side.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the present petition is accepted and the aforesaid DDR No.33 arising out of F.I.R. No.73, is hereby quashed qua the petitioners only.
