Petitioner-Satta has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.156 dated 09.03.2017, registered at Police Station Kherki Daula, Gurugram, under Sections 379 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the FIR, which was got recorded by complainant-Narsingh, on 02.03.2017, when he went to

ATM to withdraw the amount, some unknown person who was standing there, told him that he can help him to withdraw the amount. The aforesaid person took his ATM card and put it into the machine and withdrew the amount of Rs.1,000/-. Thereafter, the said person exchanged his ATM card with other ATM card dishonestly and later on got withdrawn the amount of Rs.24,000/- from his account.

The petitioner has been in custody since 12.03.2017. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. Moreover, the offences are triable by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.40,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
