This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short '**the Code**') for directing respondents No. 1 to 3 for getting FIR No. 190 dated 29.4.2017 under Sections 376-D, 506 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Tohana, District Fatehabad, investigated from some independent agency, while alleging that a fair and transparent investigation has not being conducted.

After notice had been issued in the petition, a reply by way of affidavit of Shamsher Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Tohana, has been filed, in which it is submitted that the statement of the prosecutrix has been recorded under Section 164 of the Code and all the accused i.e. respondents No. 4 to 6 have been arrested and are in judicial custody. Moreover, bail applications of the accused have also been

dismissed by the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Fatehabad.

In view of the fact that challan has been submitted in the Court on 18th July, 2017, no further orders are called for in this petition and the same is dismissed.
