The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.72 dated 25.02.2015 under Sections 328/417/120-B/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Chand Hut, District Palwal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that allegations in the FIR, which has been lodged by her brother-in-law, are that the petitioner had administered some poisonous substance to him as she had been performing tantrik activities along with Bhudev @ Radheshyam.

Learned counsel further contends that in FSL report, no poisonous substance was found in the blood samples of the complainant. He also contends that main accused Bhudev @ Radheshyam has already been granted the concession of regular

bail by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 10.07.2015 passed in CRM No. M-21392 of 2015 and the petitioner is a lady having two minor children, aged about 05 and 07 years.

In view of the fact that similarly situated co-accused has already been granted bail and the petitioner is a lady having two minor children, I deem it fit to allow this petition. Consequently, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner Rani is ordered to be released on bail subject to her furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/ Duty Magistrate.
