The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.100 dated 18.06.2016 registered under Sections 420 & 120-B IPC at Police Station Bagha Purana, District Moga.

The petitioner appears to be the main person who had opened the account to enable the others to deposit amount in the said account.

Learned State counsel submits that the amount is to the extent of one crore.

In that view of the matter, had the petitioner not opened the account, the crime would not have been committed.

I find no merit in this petition and the same is dismissed.

Interim order dated 20.09.2016 stands vacated.
