The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 18, dated 18.05.2017, under Sections 420, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Airport, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated and four FIRs have been lodged against him within a span of two and half hours.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Salwinder Singh states that the petitioner was involved in issuance of fake Malaysian visa. After obtaining money from the complainant he had furnished him visa bearing VD No. 3263377 and upon verification from the Malaysian High Commission, it has been found that no such visa was issued by the Malaysian Authorities. Learned State counsel further states that there are several other complainants, who have also come forward against the petitioner alleging issuance of forged/fake employment visas by the petitioner.

Heard.

The allegations against the petitioner are serious. He has allegedly issued fake visas to several persons after receiving money. Therefore, custodial interrogation of the petitioner would be required to unearth the entire scam. This, however, will not be construed as any expression on the merits of the case.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.
