The petitioner claims to have made some payments to respondent No.4, who is distantly related to him, on the belief that his son would be provided an employment in the Police Department, where the said respondent himself was working as Constable Homeguard. Thereafter, the petitioner was allegedly duped and constrained to lodge his complaint against the said respondent. But no action was taken thereupon and instead the petitioner is allegedly being harassed by respondent No.3 at the instance of respondent No.4. He has, therefore, approached this Court.

The present petition is disposed of with a direction upon the respondent No.2 to look into the allegations of the petitioner in his representation (Annexure P-5) and to take appropriate action thereafter.
