Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing of F.I.R. No.186 dated 18.06.2016 (Annexure-P1) under Sections 420/120-B I.P.C. pertaining to Police Station Navi Baradari, Jalandhar on the basis of compromise (Annexure-P2).

On presentation of the petition, vide order dated 12.07.2017, the petitioner as well as respondent No.2 were directed to appear before the trial Court/ Illaqa Magistrate to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the trial Court/ Illaqa Magistrate to furnish report alongwith the recorded statements qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties.

Report of the Illaqa Magistrate having Endorsement No.452 dated 21.07.2017 has been received.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana, the compromise between the parties is genuine and without any pressure or coercion.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, F.I.R. No.186 dated 18.06.2016 under Sections 420/120-B I.P.C. pertaining to Police Station Navi Baradari, Jalandhar is hereby quashed.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
