Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.578 dated 30.05.2016 under Sections 420/406/34 I.P.C. pertaining to Police Station Chandni Bagh, Panipat, on the basis of compromise.

On presentation of the petition, vide order dated 25.07.2016, parties were directed to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the trial Court to furnish a report alongwith the recorded statements qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties appeared before the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Panipat on 04.08.2016 and got recorded their

statements for compromise. Report vide covering letter No.647 dated 05.08.2016 from the concerned Magistrate duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Panipat vide letter No.10464 dated 06.08.2016 has also been received.

According to the report of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Panipat, the compromise between the parties is genuine and without any undue pressure.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the aforesaid F.I.R. No.578, is hereby quashed.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
