Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.46 dated 30.04.2016 under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Moonk, District Sangrur along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioners.
