Pleadings on record would indicate that the petitioner had served as Driver/Operator, Municipal Council, Fire Brigade, Malout, District Faridkot.

Instant petition was instituted in the year 1995 questioning the action of the respondent authorities in having retired him at the age of 58 years i.e. 30.6.1995. Claim put forth on behalf of the petitioner was that he is entitled to continue in service till attainment of 60 years of age i.e. 30.6.1997.

As per office report, the notice issued to the petitioner has been received back with a report that he has since died. Even whereabouts of the counsel, who had filed the instant petition, are not known as per the Bar Directory.

Under such peculiar circumstances, the instant writ petition is dismissed.

It would be open for the L.Rs of the petitioner to seek revival of the petition by filing an appropriate application and by demonstrating that any cause of action/relief still survives.
