Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.55 dated 21.05.2017 under Sections 307, 341, 427, 506, 148, 149 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Kot Isah Khan, District Moga.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh, states that the petitioner is not cooperating with the investigation. He has not even appeared before the investigating officer in terms of orders dated 13.07.2017, 28.08.2017 and 04.10.2017 passed by this Court.

In view of the above uncontroverted position, this Court finds that the petitioner is not entitled to the relief of anticipatory bail. The present petition is, consequently, dismissed.
