Petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to the respondents to comply the provision of Section 160 Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that FIR No.101 dated 4.11.2016, under Sections 323, 324, 452, 148, 149, 447, 448, 511 IPC, registered at Police Station Sarabha Nagar, Ludhiana has been registered at the behest of the petitioner. He further states that since the petitioner was unnecessarily called by the police, he has submitted a representation dated 5.6.2017 (Annexure P-1) addressed to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab

accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over requisite number of copies of paper book to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without commenting on the claim as projected by the petitioner in the present petition, same is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the contents of representation (Annexure P-1) and to act in accordance with law.

However, it is made clear that in case such like representation has not been received by respondent No.2, it shall not be incumbent upon him to decide the same.
