This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for quashing of order dated 20.09.2016 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Patiala.

Heard.

Inter alia in the petition it is asserted that in a complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instrument Act, 1881 filed by M/s. Raghbir Singh & Company through its partner against several persons including the petitioner, the notice was not received by the petitioner and he was wrongly declared as a proclaimed offender by the trial Magistrate.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner is ready

and willing to appear in the trial Court but some protection be given to him so that he may not be arrested once he appears in the trial Court.

Under these circumstances, the petitioner is directed to appear before the Court of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Patiala within a period of seven days from today and in case of his filing application for regular bail the same be decided within seven days thereof after giving notice to the complainant.

Till then the petitioner would not be arrested.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
