The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.61 dated 09.06.2016, registered under Sections 498-A and 406 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station City Budhlada, District Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties and they have started residing together as husband and wife.

Respondent No.2 is present in person and admits the factum of the compromise.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and in view of the compromise arrived at between the parties, he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 12.08.2016 (as modified vide order dated 23.08.2016), is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
