**FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.**

Report dated 20.08.2016 of learned Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Jalandhar has been received whereby after recording statements of complainant Manju Bala and the accused namely Sarvesh Kumar @ Vicky, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court, the fact that the offences for which the accused has been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and**

**another’ 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and ‘Kulwinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another’ 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.93 dated 20.05.2016 registered at Police Station Bhargo Camp, District Jalandhar under Sections 420, 465, 401, 471 IPC and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioner are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
