This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 620 dated 27.11.2016, registered under Sections 304-B, 302 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Sadar Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since 29.11.2016. He is the husband of the deceased. It is submitted that the complainant has been examined. It is also contended that though the FIR in question was registered under the aforesaid sections, however, the challan has been filed only under Sections 304-B and 34 of the IPC.

Upon notice, Ms. Harpreet Kaur, AAG, Haryana, has appeared on behalf of the respondent-State and opposes the grant of regular bail to the petitioner by contending that there is specific allegation of demand of dowry against the petitioner. Counsel for the respondents-State further contends that FSL report is still awaited.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and in view of the fact that since the challan has been filed and the petitioner is in custody since 29.11.2016, without going into the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the trial is likely to take some time to conclude, the present petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on her furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
