JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J.

The present petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case First Information Report No.115 dated 8.10.2016 registered under Section 306 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Anandpur Sahib, District Rupnagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that during the interregnum period, Section 302 IPC has also been added. He seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file fresh petition after adding the said Section.

Learned State counsel admits the factum of addition of Section 302 IPC and also submits that the recovery of the dead body of deceased Mohinder Kaur has not been effected.

Considering the fact that Section 302 IPC has been added during the interregnum period and the dead body of the alleged deceased Mohinder Kaur so far has not been recovered, the proposal of arrest of the petitioner, if any, is held in abeyance till 04.9.2017.

In the meantime, amended petition, if advised, be filed.

Disposed of accordingly.
