ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.207, dated 05.06.2016, under Sections 307 and 34 of IPC and Sections 25, 54, 59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Kharkhoda, District Sonipat.

In view of the fact that the trial is at the advance stage and only official witnesses remain to be examined, no ground for regular bail is made out, at this stage.

Learned counsel for the petitioner restricts his arguments and submits that the marriage of the petitioner's brother-Sumit is fixed for 07.12.2017 and 08.12.2017 and he may be granted concession of interim bail only for two days in police custody to attend the said marriage.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Udham Singh, assisted by learned counsel for the complainant, has, however, opposed the prayer for bail.

Considering the fact that there is a marriage in the family of petitioner and the learned counsel for the petitioner has not pressed the bail application on merits, this petition is disposed of with a direction to

Superintendent of Jail, District Sonapat to allow the petitioner to attend the marriage for two days i.e. 07.12.2017 and 08.12.2017 from 10.00 am to 5.00 p.m. in the police custody. The SHO, Police Station Kharkhoda, District Sonapat either himself or by deputing some police official will take the petitioner to the place of marriage venue. It is made clear that the petitioner will either make an arrangement for transportation or will pay charges for transportation from the jail premises to the place of marriage for both days.

In view of the same, petition stands disposed of.
