The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.191 dated 26.11.2016 registered under Sections 399 and 402 IPC and Sections 25, 27, 54 & 59 of the Arms Act at Police Station Sadar Jagraon, District Ludhiana (Rural).

Heard learned counsel for the rival sides.

Learned State counsel submits that there are six other cases pending against the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner pointed out judgments in three cases in which the petitioner was acquitted. The allegations against the petitioner are that he was supplier of the arms and ammunitions to the elements who are habitual in committing offence of decoity.

In view of the above facts coupled with the fact that the petitioner is facing three more cases of similar nature as well as under the

NDPS Act, I am not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Hence, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) CRL. MISC. No.M-244 OF 2017 is dismissed.
- (ii) However, the trial Court is directed to complete the trial within four months from today.
