This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 231 dated 25.11.2016, registered under Sections 304-B and 302 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Chappar, District Yamunanagar.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since 29.11.2016. She is the mother-in-law of the deceased. It is contended that initially the allegations were made only against the husband but a day later another statement was made and the Jeth, Jethani and parents-in-law were also named. The investigation is over. Challan has been presented.

Upon notice, Ms. Harpreet Kaur, AAG, Haryana, has appeared on behalf of the respondent-State and contested the bail application.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and in view of the fact that since the challan has been filed and the petitioner is in custody since 29.11.2016, without going into the merits of the case and keeping in

view the fact that the trial is likely to take some time to conclude, the present petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on her furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
