ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner has challenged the order of Additional Sessions Judge dated 05.06.2017 to the extent whereby the petitioner has been denied opportunity to lead secondary evidence with regard to the application bearing No.6427 dated 04.09.2006 sent to the police.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent No.2/complainant states that he has no objection if the petitioner is granted opportunity to lead secondary evidence with regard to the aforementioned application. He further states that this should be done in a time bound manner as the petitioner had earlier been delaying the trial.

Therefore with the consent of the parties, the order dated 05.06.2017 to the extent of denying the petitioner opportunity to lead secondary evidence with regard to the aforementioned application is set aside. The petitioner shall, however, lead secondary evidence with regard to the application dated 04.09.2006 within a period of 2 months from now. As the matter is pending adjudication before the trial Court since 2006, the trial Court is directed to conclude the trial expeditiously.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
