TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.98 dated 06.06.2007, under Sections 420 IPC and Sections 8 and 9 of Prevention of Corruption Act, registered at Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar on the basis of compromise.

This court while issuing notice of motion on 28.07.2016 had directed the parties to appear before the Trial Court and to get their statements recorded in support of the compromise.

Counsel appearing for the petitioners concedes that the statement having not been recorded before the Trial Court.

It would be apposite to take notice that on the last date of hearing i.e. 17.01.2017, Mr. Parteek Sodhi, Advocate had put in appearance on behalf of complainant/respondent no.2 and had made a statement that he has no instructions as regards any settlement having been arrived at between the parties.

Under such circumstances there would no occasion for this Court to entertain a quashing petition.

Petition is accordingly disposed of.
