Prayer of the petitioner is for conducting fair and impartial investigation into the complaint filed by the petitioner before the police.

State in the reply has taken the stand that on the statement of the petitioner and her MLR, offence under Sections 323 read with Section 34 IPC is made out. As such, DDR No.4 dated 20.8.2016 was registered at Police Station Talwara, District Hoshiarpur.

Since, the offences are non-cognizable, let the petitioner avail appropriate remedy of filing a complaint before Illaqa Magistrate. It is further stated that on the statement of Veena Devi - respondent no.6, an FIR 52 dated 19.8.2016 was registered under Sections 354, 323, 447 read with Section 34 IPC, in which after investigation, challan has been presented and charges have also been framed.

In view of the matter, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach the Illaqa Magistrate with an appropriate complaint.
