Main case

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that premises of
the petitioners have been illegally sealed by the police officers without
there being any order in this regard. He further contends that the sealing of
the shop of the husband of petitioner No.1 has adversely effected the
livelihood of the petitioners.

Learned State counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of
Krishan Kumar Panthey, DSP, Rajpura on behalf of respondents No.1 and
2 wherein it is stated that the shop in question was sealed by the police to
avoid any loss or damage to the shop and they have no objection in
opening shop of husband of petitioner No.1.

Learned counsel for the parties are ad idem that the shop of the
husband of petitioner No.1 shall be de-sealed at 11.00 A.M. on 28.08.2017.

In view of the above, this petition stands disposed of as
infructuous.
