Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuing a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to provide protection to the life and liberty of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he has purchased a tractor bearing registration No.PB-11BN-0908, Chasis No.T052310487, Engine No.E2314838, Model 2014, on which a loan from L & T Finance Company is standing. He has purchased the tractor for a consideration of Rs.4,00,000/- and the said amount was paid to respondent No.5-Jora Singh. Jasbir Singh-respondent No.6, who is father of Jora Singh has executed an agreement dated 4.7.2016 that if his son Jora Singh fails to pay the instalments of the tractor to the financier, the petitioner shall have the right to claim the above loan instalments from Jasbir Singh.

Since the petitioner is seeking protection to his life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 and 6, he has submitted a representation dated 6.7.2017 (Annexure P-3) addressed to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over requisite number of copies of paper book to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without commenting on the merits of the case as projected by the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the contents of the representation dated 6.7.2017 (Annexure P-3) and to act in accordance with law.
