This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking quashing the FIR No. 21 dated 21.02.2014, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468 and 471 IPC, registered at Police Station Moga Sadar, District Moga (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 20.07.2016 (Annexure P-2).

Vide order dated 10.11.2016, parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for getting their statement recorded. In compliance thereof, report of the judicial Magistrate/trial Court has been received, wherein, it has been stated that the statements of the complainant and the accused have been recorded. The compromise is genuine and has been entered into between the parties without any pressure, coercion and undue influence. As per record, neither any of the accused have been declared 'proclaimed offender' nor any pro-claimation proceedings are pending against any them.

Considering the aforesaid, the present petition is allowed and FIR No. 21 dated 21.02.2014, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468 and 471 IPC, registered at Police Station Moga Sadar, District Moga (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed qua the petitioners.
