The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in FIR No.141 dated 24.11.2016, under Sections 498-A, 406 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Women, District Ludhiana.

During the course of proceedings, the parties were directed to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, to explore the possibility of amicable settlement.

With the efforts of the Mediator, the matter stands settled and an agreement was drawn up on 17.07.2017. In terms of the settlement, a

total sum of Rs.3,50,000/- would be paid as full and final settlement, in lieu of dowry articles as well as permanent alimony and maintenance by the petitioner-husband to the complainant-wife. They have also agreed to part ways and file a petition under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act at Ludhiana, on or before 28.07.2017. A sum of Rs.1,00,000/- was to be paid to the complainant-wife on or before 25.07.2017.

Today, a sum of Rs.30,000/- has been handed over to the complainant-wife, who is present in court. The amount of Rs.70,000/-, which stands deposited in the Registry, be released to her.

In view of the facts that the matter stands compromised, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 30.01.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
